

- work together politically, across cultural, social, physical and economic borders
- handle conflict with greater awareness and skill
- uncover the creativity in diversity
- create the right setting to enable your organisation or community to work with different ideas and cultures
- develop innovative solutions to social, economic and environmental challenges.

Diversity will be key to the success of **Leading Together**. This means we are looking for people from the private sector, not-for-profit organisations and charities, government and small business. Most likely you will already be leading change in your work—and you should have a sense of urgency and a readiness to learn something new ... and something very different.
